Vision Statement: HEAL employs a three-prong approach to social justice reform for those harmed by Virginia's Justice system. Through Legislation, Education, and Activism/Advocacy we defend the rights of the otherwise marginalized by Virginia's sex offense laws and work to restore dignity denied and respectability to all our lives.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES OF H.E.A.L. – Virginia

- 1). WE primarily support the needs of Virginians, but communicate and coordinate with similar movements in other states for our common good.
- 2). We are NOT about acquiring Power for a Few, Self-Aggrandizement, or Money. We are NOT primarily concerned with developing an organization for sake of the institution itself. We are People-Power for Constructive Purpose.
- 3). WE stay faithful to and focused on our four-point approach.
- 4). WE are Results-Oriented. WE build a secure place for those disaffected and ignored Voices to harness the power of Change through group action.
- 5). WE therefore value the contributions of all members, and expect all members will engage with each other honestly, directly, and respectfully, without guile or malice, knowing that together we can achieve more.

Governance – Loose-Laissez-Faire

1. Meetings occur monthly or as needed, and rare run by a facilitator, not a president
2. Subject areas in which people have become experts through long acquaintance means they are in charge of that area of expertise. They are accountable to membership.
3. Board of Directors keeps the Vision and Mission pure and the Needed Focus
4. Steering Committee appointed for all new initiatives

5. Steering Comte., Members of Groups, or any appointed committees are Responsible to Group as a Whole.
